## How to use this manual:

- Be sure to read through the entire manual carefully before beginning installation.
- Read all warnings and precautions carefully and follow safety procedures
- Each Seizmik product has a “difficulty-to-install” rating based on the following:
  - Easy – uses basic hand tools and does not require any modifications to the existing structure of your vehicle. Most Seizmik products fall into this category. Hey, why be difficult?
  - Skilled – requires a little more skill to install properly. May require modifications to the vehicle (drilling, electrical, etc.) as well as the use of power tools.
  - Difficult – May require welding or extensive mechanical work for proper installation. Hardly any Seizmik products fall into this category but we had to say it.

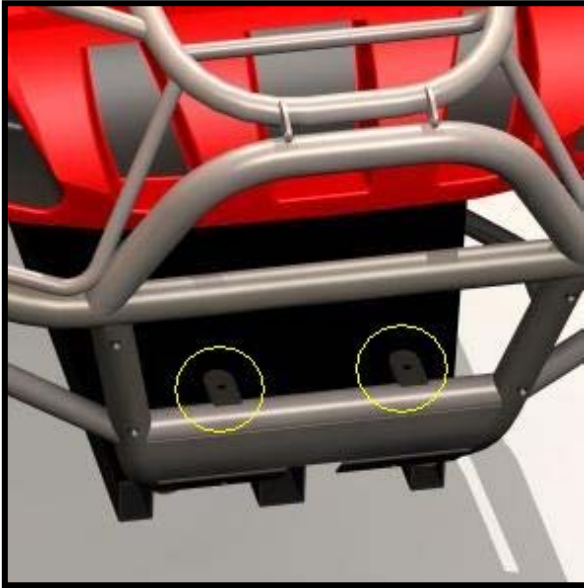

## Installation Instructions:

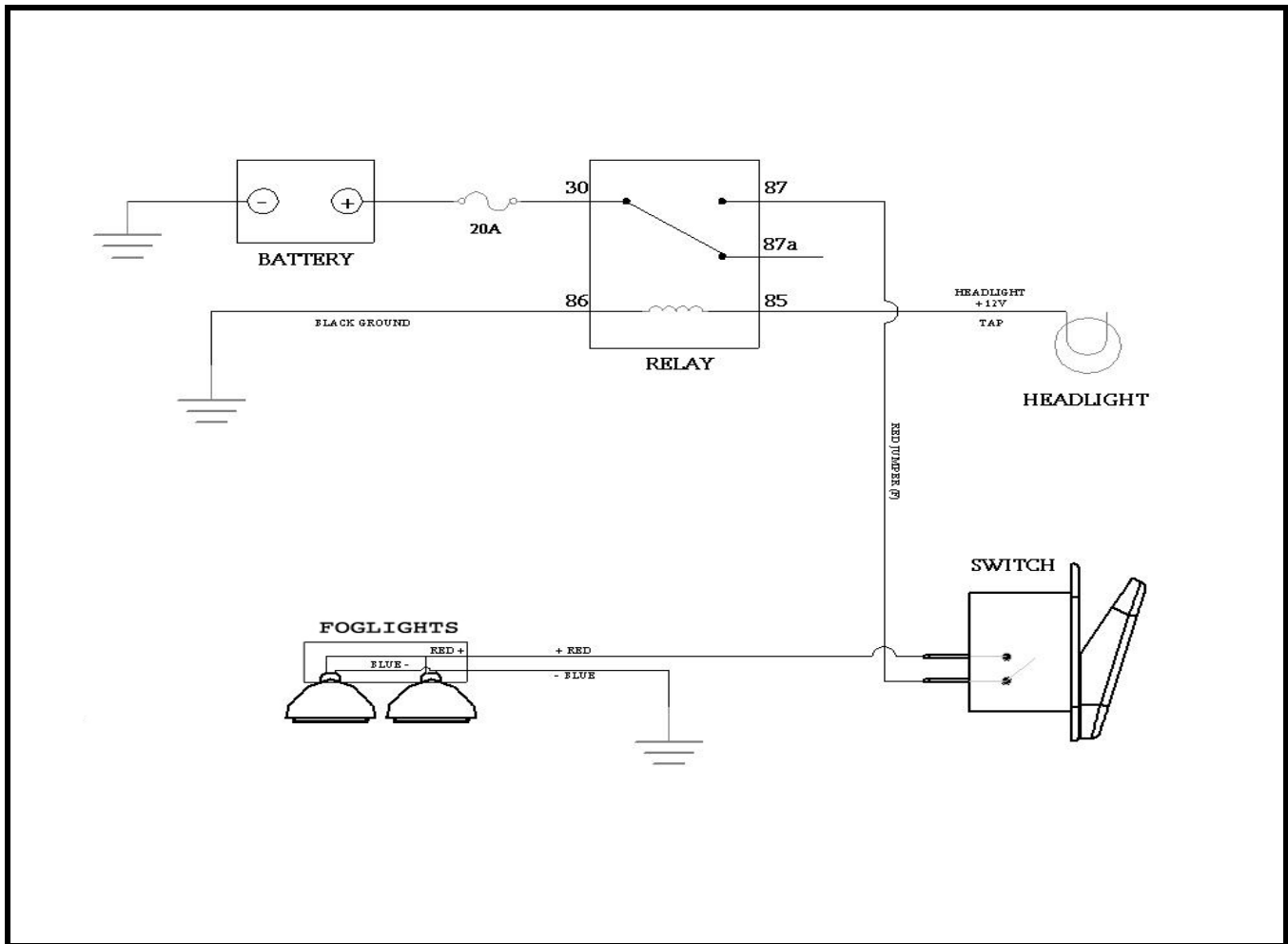
1. **Disconnect the Battery** – ALWAYS disconnect and secure the negative lead from the battery before connecting any new electrical wiring to your vehicle.
2. **Connect Fog Lights to Bumper** – Attach the two fog lights to the mounting tabs on the front bumper.



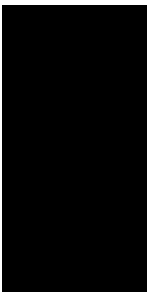
Fog light mounting tabs are marked by the yellow circles.

3. **Connect Main Wiring Harness to Fog Lights** – Using the end connectors, connect the leads from the fog lights to the main wiring harness.
4. **Layout Wiring Harness** – Run the wiring harness from the fog lights up to the battery compartment. Make sure to leave enough room to make the connections but do not let the wire interfere with any mechanical components.
5. **Install the Switch** – Using the template provided find a suitable location on the dash or inside the glove compartment to mount the switch for the lights. Remember: measure twice, cut once.
6. **Connecting Everything** – Once the switch is installed, connect the switch to the wiring harness and connect the whole assembly to the battery as shown. Don't forget to reconnect your battery after everything is connected.

7. **Wiring Tip** – It's probably best to choose either the hot lead to your headlights or an ignition wire as your power side of the relay. This way, the headlights will only operate if the ignition is on.
