(1) Remove 4 screws on both sides of the center cover. (2) Carefully place the base of the center console above the center cover. Then secure the base of the center console with the provided hardware using the original screw holes. Do not tighten yet. (3) Gently slide the middle section of the center console to fit directly above the base and be sure it is placed flat on the base. Secure the middle section on the base with the provided hardware. Do not tighten yet. (4) Then gently slide the top section of the center console to fit directly above the middle section. Be careful as not to scratch any parts on the dashboard of the vehicle. Secure the top section on the middle section with the provided hardware. Do not tighten yet. Carefully adjust all three sections (base, middle, top sections) until they are fully rested flat and perpendicular

to the floor. Then tighten all screws carefully as not to strip any of the hardware. Once everything is properly secured, install the the door with the provided hardware. Be sure to tighten all screws of the center console.

Once everything is secured, begin connecting all wires to their corresponding positive/negative points. The console can be recharged with the provided double-ended charger cable. (5, 6)

IMPORTANT: Be sure the middle section of the center console is not in the way of the throttle linkage near the pedal.

Be sure the center console is secured before operating the vehicle. Be careful of any sharp corners of the center console.
